INTRODUCING HUMANITIX

CPAC Musical Theatre has partnered with Humanitix for our season of Charlie and the Chocolate Factory to support children's charities.

High school mates Adam McCurdie and Josh Ross founded Humanitix after making a pact between them to escape the corporate world and do something meaningful.

Like many social entrepreneurs, they looked for industries with inefficiencies that could be disrupted - for good! Then it came to them: tickets! Event ticketing has always been frustrating for hosts and guests alike and everyone hates booking fees. Fast forward to today and they have transformed over \$1M from those annoying booking fees into helping disadvantaged kids around the world.

What that means for you...

The booking fee starts at \$2.99 per ticket (which is cheaper than Trybooking and the Cardinia Cultural Centre) This is a fee that CPAC usually absorbs and it now gets donated to charity.

CPACMT don't earn this money as profit. So you will notice that this fee is tacked onto your amount when you book your tickets. Don't Panic. These funds are donated to a worthwhile cause that CPACMT support - 'The Support Act Wellbeing Hotline'.



You can also make a further tax-deductible donation of any desired amount to CPAC's chosen charity. 'The Support Act Wellbeing Helpline' is staffed by professional counsellors who offer expertise in all areas related to mental health. It is free, confidential and open to anyone in music or the arts.

You will also note that ticket prices have increased. Where once GST was not applicable, as an NFP organisation GST is now part of our lives. Ticket prices are now inclusive of GST. For CPAC MT to continue producing theatre, as theatre prices increase and the cost of living goes up, so must we grow and change with the world around us.

However, we will strive to do our best to continue to provide low-cost entertainment to the community and keep bringing you the shows you know and love.

WHAT WE HAVE BEEN UP TOO.


